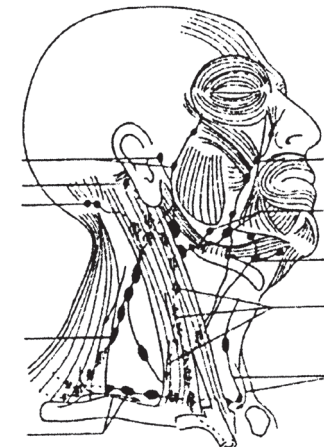

## Course Description

Ultrasound of the head and neck is a rapidly developing field. High-resolution ultrasound lends itself to assessment and diagnosis in this area. Ultrasound can be used as the primary imaging modality for many conditions that present in the head and neck, in combination with ultrasound guided fine needle aspiration or core biopsy it becomes a highly specific diagnostic tool. It's use in "one-stop clinics" is increasing.

The workshop has been designed to give a practical insight into the use of ultrasound in the head and neck.

This programme will consist of a series of formal lectures, practical demonstrations and "hands on" teaching sessions using phantoms and patients. The course will run over two days. The first day will consist of an introduction to the use of Ultrasound in the Head & Neck, Anatomy & Techniques.

A workshop to allow "Hands-On" teaching on Anatomy, & Pathology will take place in the afternoon session. There will be a "hands on" session on biopsy techniques on the second day. We will also present the latest developments in Interventional Techniques and a review of common pitfalls.

Numbers will be restricted to enable effective "Hands-On" teaching sessions, so early application is advised.
